LOCATION

Mothers Beach, Marina Del Rey

DIRECTIONS FOR TRAILERS AND CARS (SEE MAP)

***** Modified from previous years route due to construction on Washington Blvd. *****

FROM THE NORTH and SOUTH:

405 FWY to the I-90 west

EXIT-(R)Lincoln Blvd. (you will then PASS Washington Blvd.)

(L) Venice Blvd. (you will then pass Abbott Kinney and Washington Way)

(L) Ocean Ave. which turns into Via Marina

(L) Admiralty Way

(R) Palawan Way – trailers only!

TRAILERS - unload trailers to the right and park trailers at lot across from beach. Please keep this street clear from congestion to expedite unloading of canoes.

CARS – 2 parking lots on Admiralty Way, before and after Palawan Way. 3rd parking lot entrance – from Via Marina then (L) Panay Way. (See Map)

Parking: 3 lots for cars available. Parking is \$6 per vehicle. Please try to bring correct change to speed cars through. Parking will go fast, so come early to get a good spot. Do not park at the restaurant, you will be TOWED!

For Trailers: \$18 - Unload at the beach, and park at the lot across the street. Only trailers will be allowed to park in this lot. As a courtesy, Marina Members will assist in unloading. Please ensure your club members arrive early to assist.

RACE COURSE:

Novice: Approx. 4 mile race will start in the main channel to North exit of breakwater to Venice Pier. Turn and return back to enter from the South side of the breakwater. Finish will be in front of Mother's Beach.

Open: Approx. 11 mile race will start outside the breakwater north to Santa Monica Pier on a triangle course (weather permitting). Turn and re-enter from the South side of the breakwater. Finish will be in front of Mother's Beach.

Note: Courses shown are approximate. SCORA officials will determine exact course.

DIRECTIONS FOR TRAILERS AND CARS TO MOTHERS BEACH, MARINA DEL REY (SEE MAP)

FROM THE NORTH and SOUTH:

405 FWY to the I-90 west

EXIT-(R)Lincoln Blvd. (you will then PASS Washington Blvd.)

(L) Venice Blvd. (you will then pass Abbott Kinney and Washington Way)

(L) Ocean Ave. which turns into Via Marina

(L) Admiralty Way

(R) Palawan Way – trailers only!

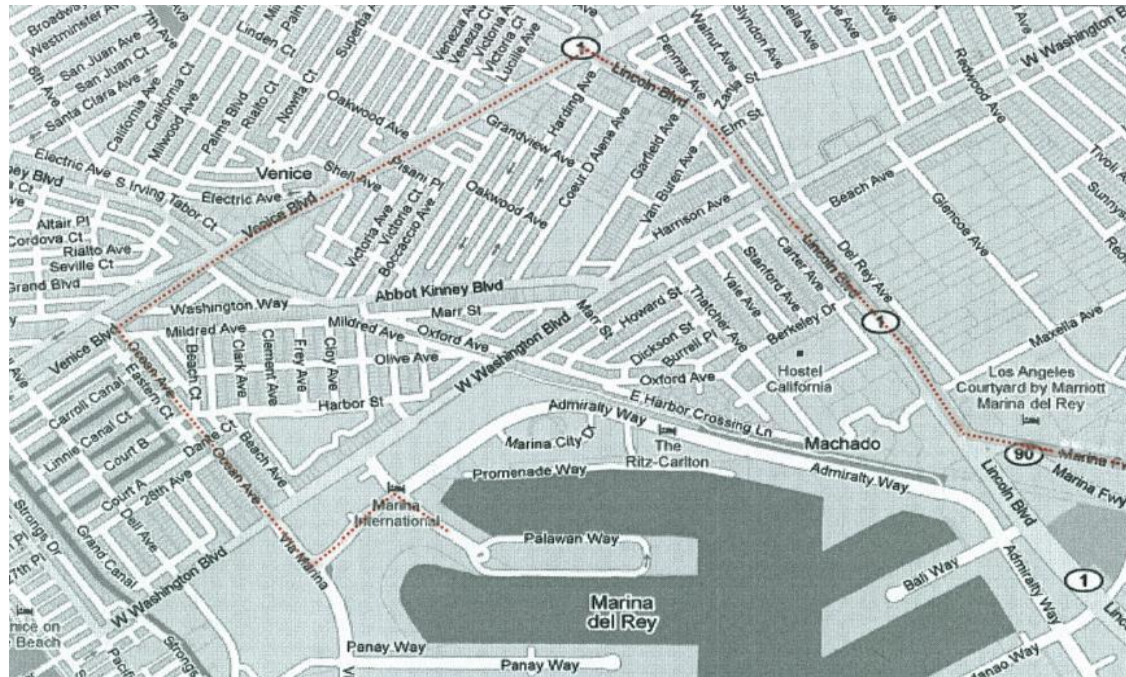
TRAILERS - unload trailers to the right and park trailers at lot across from beach.

Please keep this street clear from congestion to expedite unloading for canoes.

Drivers **must** stay with their vehicles during unloading.

CARS – 2 parking lots on Admiralty Way, before and after Palawan Way.

3rd parking lot entrance – from Via Marina then (L) Panay Way. (See Map on back)



As a courtesy, Marina Members will assist with unloading the canoes from 5:30 am - 6:30 am from the trailers to the immediate beach area. But will NOT be transporting them down to the water/rigging site. Please make sure your club members arrive early to receive canoes and move to the beach site for rigging.

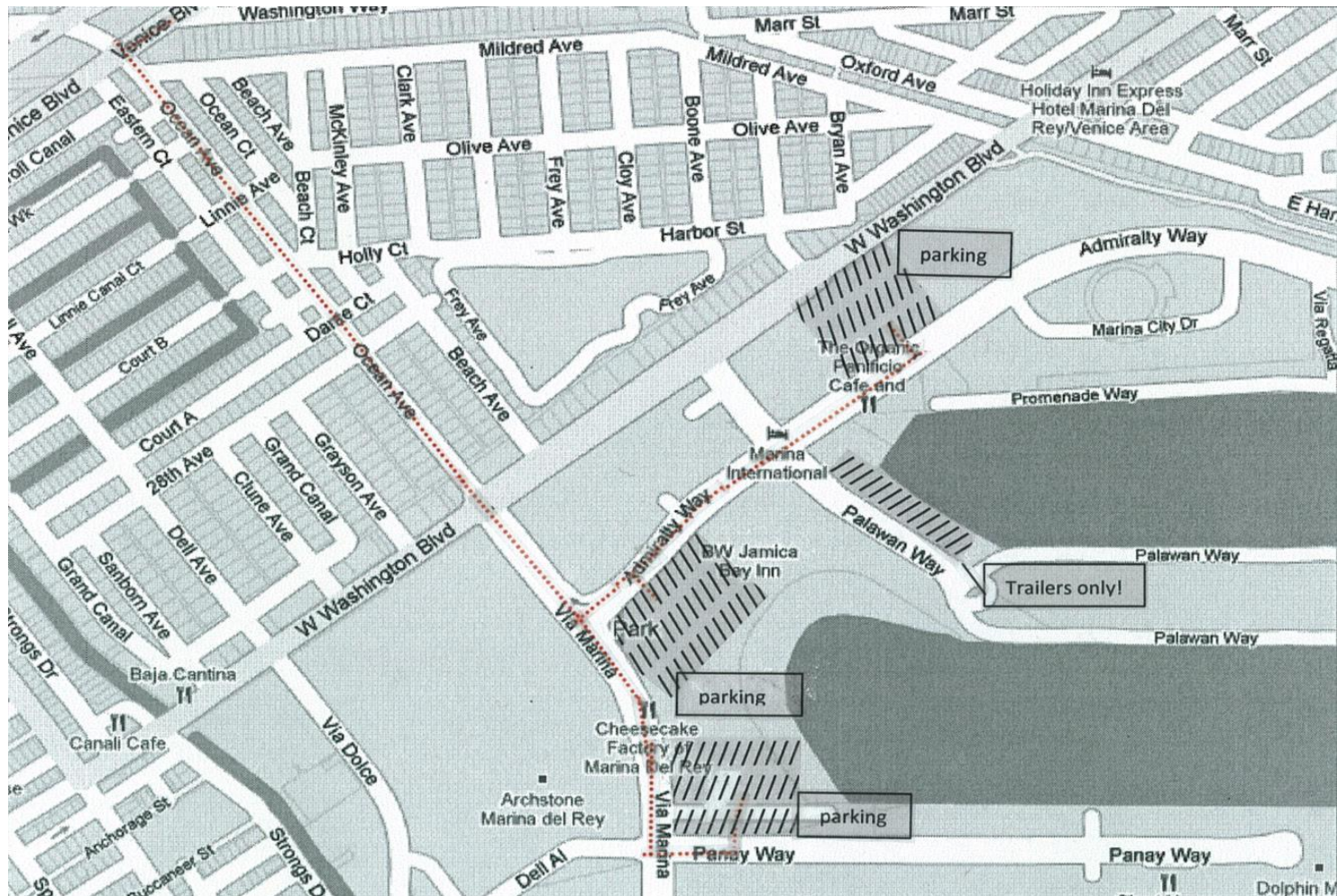
PARKING

3 lots for cars available. Parking is \$6 per vehicle. Please try to bring correct change to speed cars through. Parking will go fast, so come early to get a good spot. The Waterfront Restaurant will also provide parking for a fee. See signs at restaurant parking lot for fee on race day.

For Trailers: \$18 - Unload at the beach, and park at the lot across the street. Only trailers will be allowed to park in this lot. Please note, there is NO overnight parking in the designated trailer lot on Palawan Way. Violators will be cited.

There is overnight boat parking on Fiji Way - please see website for details.

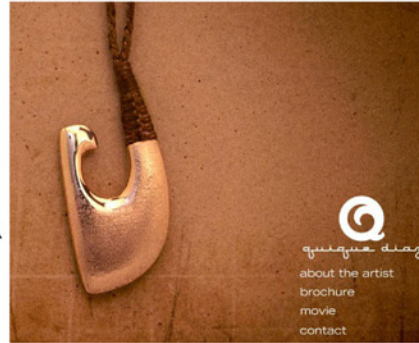
